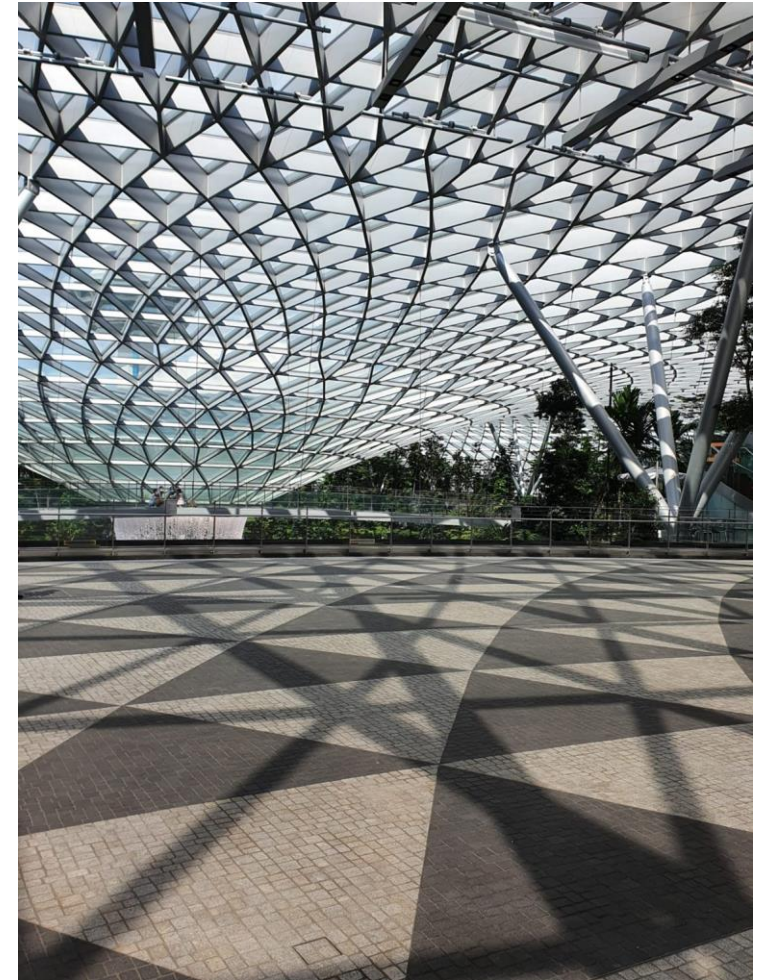




Audio Visual Aid Club
